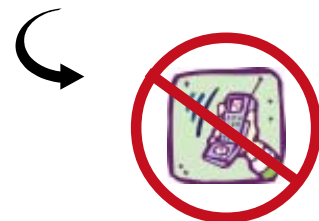

member list you must login. When the website was upgraded in July you received an email with a new password if your old password did not enough characters. It is a great way to stay current during the year!

A Great Way to Support The Rotary Foundation!

The Rotary International Platinum Plus Credit Card pays to the Rotary International Foundation® 1% for every purchase paid for with your credit card. The Foundation has received \$5,500,000 and only a small percentage of Rotarians use the card.

There is no annual fee for the card and it has all of the rewards that most other cards have. A brief description of the awards is that for each dollar spent you get 1 World Point. There are numerous avenues of rewards, merchandise, and airline tickets - but basically

you get \$250 for every 25,000 points.

One of our members has accumulated 100,000 points and has purchased two tickets on Alaska Airlines with the points. But the great bonus is that Rotary International has received \$500.

Another bonus is that when you apply for the card and charge \$75 in the first 60 days - they will send you a check for \$25 payable to “The Rotary Club.” So our Rotary Club will also benefit! For more information or an application see Tom Judy.
