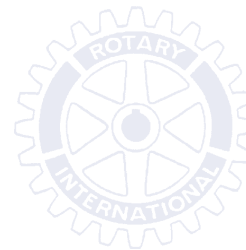
from President Jan Herkelrath

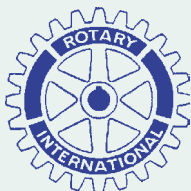

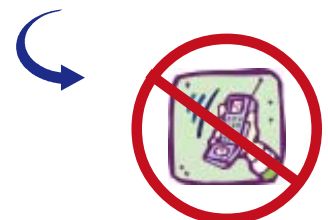

International Service *From Pete and Helen Maxwell*

At our last board meeting our first International Service project for the year was approved. We have teamed up on a matching grant with Orange North to provide medical and office equipment for a medical facility in Leon, Mexico. This is our fourth joint project in Leon.

We have received several other requests from neighboring clubs that we are investigating. One is from Irvine Spectrum to provide a new mobile van for Dental Care for Children. Dental Care for Children does seven dental clinics per year in both California and Mexico. Irvine Spectrum club helps with three of these clinics. The current vehicle has over 250,000 miles on it and doesn't

have the capacity they need to carry all of the equipment. This a multi-win project - kids in need get free dental care, DCFC gets a new vehicle, everyone gets publicity. The project will be an International Matching Grant with Club Rotario Ensenada Calafia.

Several of our members have expressed interest in donating money for international projects that are of particular interest to them. With matching funds from District and Rotary Foundation much more can be done than can be done individually - \$1,000 becomes \$3,000+. If you have any interest please contact us.
