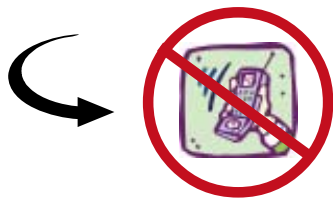

Last month we wrote about the possibility of joining with Irvine Spectrum Rotary Club to provide a new mobile van for Dental Care for Children. We now have board approval and will participate in this Matching Grant project. Irvine Spectrum is planning a trip to Ensenada that they take twice yearly. The date of service is November 17 but many go down on Friday and return Sunday morning. They normally stay at the Hotel Coral, a really great hotel just north of the Downtown area. It has great rooms and they give us a 30% discount - the rooms are about \$100 a night and all look out over the yacht harbor and ocean. They may not have the new van for the November trip but it is a great opportunity for international service. They also do maintenance and support for the school. It's a good idea to bring along items to donate -

especially school supplies, books (in Spanish if possible), clothing, etc. There is a great need for anything and everything.

We continue to look at other international projects and have great hope that we will be able to participate in another matching grant with either the Ukraine or Poland.
